A non-refundable fee of K400 (K100 Administration Fee and K300 Exam Fee) must accompany this application.

The Bachelor of Medicine & Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) program:

Candidates applying will be required to sit for an entry exam as part of the selection process for the program. A Non- Refundable Exam Fee of K300 will be charged and must be paid to sit the exam. The selection is competitive and will be based on the results of the entry exam that consists of 5 subjects: Language and Literature (20%), Advanced Mathematics (15%), Biology (25%), Chemistry (25%) and Physics (15%). Successful candidates will be ranked according to their exam results. Only those ranked high in the top 15 will be accepted for the program. The exam will be organized in the following DWU centres: Madang (main campus), POM DWU campus, Rabaul St Mary School of Nursing, Wewak St Benedict School of Nursing and Mt Hagen – Rabiamul, SVD House. A fee of K400 (K100 Administration Fee and K300 Exam Fee) must be paid to the DWU BSP Account to sit the exam. This payment must be submitted when lodging your application. Submitted application without the required fees will be considered null and void and will not be processed for consideration. Candidates will be responsible for their own logistical arrangements to sit for the entry exam. The exam dates will be announced by mid-August. Candidates must submit a reliable email address as information for the exam, and dates will be sent via your email.

Before submitting your application to the Divine Word University (DWU), please make sure:

- that you met the program entry requirements of the program you are applying for
- that you fill out all required sections in this application form
- that you have paid all required fees as part of the application process.

The final selections for Non-School Leaver applicants will be carried out via the National Online Selection System (NOSS), therefore you will be required to apply to your choice of program through the NOAS. The NOAS is administered by the Department of Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology (DHERST).

Below, you will find the data sheet. The information provided in this data sheet will be used by DHERST to create your login credentials on the online system. You will receive an invitation through your nominated personal email as indicated on your data sheet to apply directly through the NOAS. **It is a requirement that the applicant must have completed their formal Grade 12.** For any student who has undergone studies through FODE or Matriculation Centers, must contact the respective centers to ensure their results have been uploaded to NOAS. Applicants must contact the Support Office of NOAS at DHERST to address any issues pertaining to your data and results.

Applicants will only be able to see programs for which the applicant meets the program entry requirement that they are eligible to apply for on NOAS. Spaces for each program are limited. To increase your chance of securing a space in the DWU program for which you apply, **ensure that you make it your first choice when completing your online registration.**
