

NOTICE TO NEW INTAKES AND RETURNING DEGREE STUDENTS FOR 2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

Congratulations to all new intakes and returning degree students accepted to attend Divine Word University in 2022.

The following information provided is to ensure you are prepared to enroll for the 2022 academic year without issues.

Registration

The Official Registration will begin on Monday the 7th of February 2022 and end on Friday the 11th of February 2022 at the St. John Paul II Multipurpose Hall. Students are also expected to attend compulsory orientation program once they register. See campus map and details of the registration process downloadable with this notice.

There will be two lines for Registration. One line will be for continuing students and the other for new intakes. Look out for signage on Registration Day. Mask wearing and 1.5 social distancing is mandatory during registration.

As per registration policy, failure to register during official registration week may affect your eligibility to be enrolled at the University. A fee of K20.00 per day is charged for late registration. You are advised to contact the Registrar's Office by emailing mcregistration@dwu.ac.pg should you have a genuine reason for registering late. There will be no registration of students after the 18th of February 2022.

Mandatory Documents for Registration

- 1. Your acceptance letter
- 2. Original Grade 12 certificate It is an absolute requirement that your original Grade 12 certificate is presented during registration.
- 3. Student Finance Form completed
- 4. Conditions for Enrolment 2022 completed
- 5. DWU Medical Form completed— Medicals are mandatory during registration for all students. Only DWU Medical Forms will be accepted. The Medical Form must be stamped and dated current by the facilitating Practitioner/ Clinic where medicals were attempted
- 6. The Sports Waiver Form (if you are under 21 years of age)
- 7. Circular on Zero Tolerance Read before you complete and sign Declaration Form
- 8. Declaration Form
- 9. Copyright Act Waiver To be completed by all students taking Bachelor of Communication Arts (Journalism)

Optional documents for Registration

1. COVID 19 Vaccination Record Card completed – COVID 19 vaccination remains optional but is strongly recommended. Those students who have done their vaccination can present their vaccination card as evidence of their vaccination.

Student Orientation

All new intakes are expected to attend compulsory orientation program once they register. The orientation program can be download with this notice.

Fees

It is first important that students register by paying the "On-Registration Fee" according to the program they are undertaking. **The "DWU Fee Schedule 2022"** is now available for download on the DWU website for ease of information and to know how much is required to be paid by the student.

The following is the summary on how much should be paid for the year, depending on the students' Sponsorship status, i.e. whether you are on Government Sponsored through the Tertiary Education, Study Assistance Scheme (TESAS) administered by the Department of Higher Education, Science, Research and Technology (DHERST) or not.

STUDENTS ON TESAS (TERTIARY EDUCATION STUDY ASSISTANCE SCHEME) administered by the Department of Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology

- TESAS Sponsored students taking MBBS and Rural Health programs: Students on HECAS must pay K5,376.00 to register and Students on AES must pay K4,368.00 to register. To live on campus (Residential), a fee of K6,900.00 must be paid in addition to your on-registration fee. The balance of your total tuition fee of K2,304.00 (HECAS) or K1,872.00 (AES) must be paid before the 31st of May 2022 to complete your tuition fees. Refer to the 2022 DWU Fee Schedule for advice.
- TESAS Sponsored students taking Physiotherapy program: Students on HECAS must pay K4,536.00 to register and Students on AES must pay K3,528.00 to register. To live on campus (Residential), a fee of K6,900.00 must be paid in addition to your on-registration fee. The balance of your total tuition fee of K1,944.00 (HECAS) or K1,512.00 (AES) must be paid before the 31st of May 2022 to complete your tuition fees. Refer to the 2022 DWU Fee Schedule for advice.
- TESAS Sponsored students taking all other programs: Students on HECAS must pay K2,016.00 to register and Students on AES must pay K1,008.00 to register. To live on campus (Residential), a fee of K6,900.00 must be paid in addition to your on-registration fee. The balance of your total tuition fee of K864.00 (HECAS) or K432.00 (AES) must be paid before the 31st of May 2022 to complete your tuition fees. Refer to the 2022 DWU Fee Schedule for advice.
- Students on TESAS are required to pay their "On-Registration Fee" to register.
- TESAS Sponsored students who want to declare/ have intentions to apply for the Higher Education Loan Program (HELP) administered by the Department of Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology (DHERST) are required to pay their "On-Registration Fee".

SELF- SPONSORED FULL TIME UNDERGRADUATE AND POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

Self-Sponsored students are required to pay their "On-Registration Fee" to first register. The total balance of fee must be paid before the 31st of May 2022. These are the categories of registration fees students must pay according to the program undertaken.

• Self-Sponsored students taking MBBS and RH programs: Self-Sponsored students must pay K8,400.00 to register. To live on campus (Residential), a fee of K6,900.00 must be paid in addition to your on-registration fee. The balance of your total tuition fee of K3,600.00 must be paid before the 31st of May 2022 to complete your tuition fees. Refer to the 2022 DWU Fee Schedule for advice.

- Self-Sponsored students taking Physiotherapy program: Self-Sponsored students must pay K7,560.00 to register. To live on campus (Residential), a fee of K6,900.00 must be paid in addition to your on-registration fee. The balance of your total tuition fee of K3,240.00 must be paid before the 31st of May 2022 to complete your tuition fees. Refer to the 2022 DWU Fee Schedule for advice.
- Self-Sponsored students taking all other programs: Self-Sponsored students must pay K5,040.00 to register. To live on campus (Residential), a fee of K6,900.00 must be paid in addition to your on-registration fee. The balance of your total tuition fee of K2,160.00 must be paid before the 31st of May 2022 to complete your tuition fees. Refer to the 2022 DWU Fee Schedule for advice.
- Self-Sponsored students taking Postgraduate programs: Self-Sponsored Postgraduate students must pay K7,350.00 to register. To live on campus (Residential), a fee of K6,900.00 must be paid in addition to your on-registration fee. The balance of your total tuition fee of K3,150.00 must be paid before the 31st of May 2022 to complete your tuition fees. Refer to the 2022 DWU Fee Schedule for advice.
- Self- Sponsored students who want to declare/ have intentions to apply for the Higher Education Loan Program (HELP) administered by the Department of Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology (DHERST) are required to pay their "On-Registration Fee".
- Self-Sponsored students must pay the balance of the total tuition fee before the 31st of May 2022 to avoid de-registration. Refer to the "2022 DWU Fee Schedule".

CORPORATE- SPONSORED STUDENTS

The tuition fee for Corporate-Sponsored students is fixed across all full-time programs.

• Corporate-Sponsored students across all full-time programs: Students must pay K21,000.00 to register. To live on campus (Residential), a fee of K6,900.00 must be paid in addition to your onregistration fee. The balance of your total tuition fee of K9,000.00 must be paid before the 31st of May 2022 to complete your tuition fees. Refer to the 2022 DWU Fee Schedule for advice.

"All other programs" referred to in the summary are non-clinical programs. These programs are Bachelor of Arts (Social & Religious Studies), Bachelor of Arts (PNG Studies and International Relations), Bachelor of Communication Arts (Journalism), Bachelor of Business (Accountancy and Management), Bachelor of Information Systems, Bachelor of Mathematics and Computing Science, Bachelor of Tourism and Hospitality Management, Bachelor Environmental Health and Bachelor of Health Management.

All students to take note that:

- Money for student allowances, or cheques including school fee for other siblings MUST NOT be paid into the DWU account.
- The Boarding and Lodging fee of K6,900.00 is a separate fee from the tuition fee and must be paid in full to secure accommodation on campus.

Method of Payment of Fees

Students must identify your program and the required On-Registration fee that needs to be paid before registering. If you wish to live on campus, a fee of K6,900.00 must be paid in addition to your "On-

Registration Fee". The balance of the total tuition fee must be paid before the 31st of May 2022. **NO GUARANTEE LETTERS FROM SPONSORS WILL BE ACCEPTED DURING REGISTRATION.**

Please ensure that payment is made directly to the DWU Bank Account before you come for Enrolment and Registration. Below are the bank details you must use to deposit your fees.

Students are asked to send a copy of your payment Bank Deposit Slip to the Students' Finance Officer on Fax No: 422 2812 or by email: tuitionfees@dwu.ac.pg. Your original payment slip/deposit payment slip must be presented during registration. Should you wish to request for your Proforma School Fee Invoice, you can email tuitionfees@dwu.ac.pg with the email subject: Request for Proforma School Fee Invoice- your ID No.

Students are expected not travel to Divine Word University without paying the required On-Registration fee, as you will not be registered until the required fees have been paid in full.

Student Accommodation and COVID Checks

COVID 19 check is compulsory for all students to undergo upon arrival on campus. A COVID 19 check booth will be set up adjacent to the library. Once students are reported cleared from COVID and have paid both their boarding and lodging fee and On-Registration Fee will proceed to the Dormitory Deans to collect room keys. Students who have not paid for their boarding and lodging fee will not be given a room key and will need to seek accommodation elsewhere until this fee is paid. You will need to present the original copy of your fee deposits to sight during these checks. Students are asked to keep their original fee deposit receipts safe.

Placement Acceptance Slip

All new intakes must confirm respective placement by 31st January 2022. The placement slip is provided at the end of your acceptance letter. This slip must be completed and emailed to the Office of the Registrar at the following email address mcregistration@dwu.ac.pg

Travel to Campus

Self-sponsored students travelling by air, road or sea must pay for their own travel cost. Students who are under TESAS must contact DHERST Scholarships Division to confirm travel arrangement.
