As per registration policy, please note that failure to register during official registration week may affect a student's eligibility to be enrolled at DWU St. Mary's School Of Nursing. A fee of K20.00 per is charged for late registration. Students are advised to contact the Head of Department Office by email should they have a genuine reason for registering late. There will be no registration of students after the 16th of February 2024.
