#### COVID 19 OBSERVANCE PROTOCOLS FOR BOTH CONTINUING AND NEW STUDENTS

As part of the latest COVID 19 protocol issued by the Controller, the University has set up a booth to screen all students arriving at Madang campus for possible signs of contracting the Coronavirus.

The booth will operate from 8.00 am to 7.00 pm each day starting on Monday 1 February to Sunday 14 February, 2021.

All arriving students; both continuing and new will be strictly checked first at the main gate by the University Rangers to ensure everyone entering wears a mask.

The screening booth which is setup between Global travel and the IT building carry out a rapid check on the following:

1. To ensure all wear face masks before entering the campus
2. Each person will be issued the COVID-19 Check form to complete and hand in to Nursing Officers at the booth
3. Temperature checks will be done.
4. Any student showing signs of Coronavirus will be referred to the DWU COVID-19 Centre for further assessment.
5. It is advisable that students arrive at the campus before 7.00 pm. No student will be processed after 7.00 pm because the booth will be closed.

#### **Dormitory Room Allocation Requirement**

6. Allocation of rooms will be done based on payment of 70% fees up-front or parental component if you are on TESAS. Students must ensure to bring fee receipts with you
